- So many dogs are turning up on the streets. One of Sashko's sisters has pups hidden somewhere near the town centre. There is a pack of 15 dogs just out of the centre which are so scared that we can't get near them. Today another dog that we haven't seen before turned up in the centre. Then we have the poor collie who is desperate to come in but we haven't the room for him. We desperately need a shelter so we can help more dogs.

### NEW ARRIVALS. TODD, BUDDY AND KEEGAN

Brownie gave birth to a single pup on the 4th May. The pup is a little boy and is called Todd. With no rivals for his mum's milk, he is a large and chubby pup. Brownie has been a brilliant mum and both are fine.



Buddy arrived on the 9th May when he was between 4 and 5 weeks old. A neighbour's dog had given birth to a litter of pups and Buddy was the only one to survive. Buddy had severe worm infestation when

he arrived. He has now been treated and is doing well.



Keegan was found by Luke on the 16th May. Luke was in the town centre when there was a really bad thunderstorm and torrential rain. He found Keegan crying under a bench.

Keegan was barely 4 weeks old. He has been treated for parasites and is now getting good food and puppy milk. There was no sign of any other pups. Keegan and Buddy are

now together in the smaller of the puppy runs.
